⚠ WARNING! All recipients of this mandatory stop use notice must read, understand and follow all instructions. Failure to do so may result in serious injury or death.

At Honeywell, our mission is to be the global leader in personal protective equipment with innovative solutions that protect and save lives. In line with our commitment to our mission statement, we are writing

to inform you of potentially non-conforming brake components in certain models of Miller MightEvac and MightyLite Self-Retracting Lifelines (SRLs) ranges manufactured within a specific timeframe. **While there have been NO reported incidents due to this nonconformity, continued use of the product could result in serious injury or death.**

Products included in this notice must be removed from use:

This notice only affects the models listed in Table 1 with identified manufacturing dates or re-certification dates between October 27, 2016, and October 6, 2018. Models outside of this date range, including new units, are not affected by this notice.

Attached in this notice are the following items:

1. A **“Stop Use Notice”** that must be sent to all your customers who have purchased the part numbers included in Table 1 – please see attached
2. A list of the affected part numbers (Table 1) - please see attached

Please take the following steps immediately:

1. Identify your customer(s) who have purchased the models affected by this notice after October 2016.
2. Send a copy of the enclosed **“MANDATORY STOP USE NOTICE”** to the customers you identify, no later than August 30, 2019.
3. Upon completion of your mailing of the **“MANDATORY STOP USE NOTICE”**, a confirmation must be sent to Honeywell at the following e-mail with a list of customers that were informed:

4. Inspect your on-hand inventory for the models and date codes detailed above. If you have one of the specified units, remove them from your inventory. Honeywell will provide details for how to ship the impact products back to Honeywell.

If you prefer Honeywell to send the **“MANDATORY STOP USE NOTICE”** packet directly to your customers, please send us an electronic file with all of your customers who purchased these units. The file should be in Excel or a text tab-delimited format. It must include the company name, a contact name, e-mail and the mailing address including street or P.O. Box, city, state, and country. This file must be provided to Honeywell by **September 06, 2019** and should be emailed to us at is.ppe.techsupport.europe@honeywell.com. The information that you send to us will be kept strictly confidential.

NEXT STEPS

We have already determined a solution for the potential non-conforming brake components for affected models of Miller MightEvac and MightyLite Self-Retracting Lifelines (SRLs), which will require replacement of the brake component part at our repair center. We apologize for the inconvenience this may cause and potential business disruption. We urge you to immediately discontinue use of affected units to avoid safety risks.

Our team is working to streamline the return and repair process. **Replacement of the brake component will be free of charge and at no additional cost to you.** We will provide you with more details on the return process.
